General Information

Introduction to Info Source

Info Source describes the programs and activities, and the information holdings related to programs and activities, of government institutions subject to the [Access to Information Act](#) to facilitate the right of access. It also provides individuals, including current and former employees of the Government of Canada, with relevant information to access personal information about themselves held by government institutions subject to the [Privacy Act](#) and to exercise their rights under the *Privacy Act*.

An [index of institutions](#) that are subject to the *Access to Information Act* and the *Privacy Act* is available centrally.

The *Access to Information Act* and the *Privacy Act* assign overall responsibility to the President of Treasury Board (as the designated Minister) for the government-wide administration of the legislation.

Context

Canada Growth Fund Inc. (“CGF”) is a \$15 billion independent investment fund, operating at arm’s length from the Government of Canada. To keep Canada competitive on the global stage and to ensure it continues to be a leading destination for investment, CGF was established to drive innovation across new and traditional sectors of Canada’s industrial base. Its investment mandate consists of building a financially prudent portfolio of investments that unlock private sector investment in Canadian businesses and projects to help grow Canada’s economy at speed and scale on the path to emissions reductions, in the interest of remaining competitive globally over the longer term (the “CGF Mandate”).

CGF is a wholly owned subsidiary of Canada Development Investment Corporation (“CDEV”).

Canada Growth Fund Investment Management Inc. (“CGFIM”) is a wholly owned subsidiary of the Public Sector Pension Investment Board (“PSPIB”), incorporated in August 2023 to act as the exclusive, independent, arm’s-length investment manager of CGF. CGFIM provides investment management services to CGF pursuant to an Investment Management Agreement dated March 11, 2024 among CGF, CGFIM, PSPIB and CDEV (the “IMA”). The CGFIM team has full discretionary authority over all aspects of investment management and transactions. Individual investment decisions are made by CGFIM’s investment committee based on investment acumen and fit with the CGF Mandate. All investment decisions are made in strict independence from the Government of Canada



Responsibilities

As the exclusive, independent, arm's-length investment manager of CGF, CGFIM is responsible for constructing and managing CGF's investment portfolio in support of the CGF Mandate. CGFIM is comprised of a team of seasoned investment professionals leveraging experience from numerous asset classes, including infrastructure, private equity and natural resources.

CGFIM's aim is to leverage its team's investment judgement to build a portfolio of CGF investments aligned with the CGF Mandate at the speed and scale required to maximize its impact. To operationalize the CGF Mandate, CGFIM has developed frameworks and tools to translate each of CGF's strategic objectives into pillars and key performance indicators, to complement CGF's statutory financial reporting.



Institutional Programs and Activities

Investment Management

The investment of assets on behalf of CGF in support of the CGF Mandate.

Investment Management – Class of Records

Description: Includes all documents and information supporting investment activities and associated risk analysis. It includes records related to portfolio construction, the review, selection, acquisition, management, and divestiture of investment assets, risk analysis and reporting, and the monitoring and evaluation of investment performance.

Document Types: Investment documentation, risk analysis reports, audit reports, correspondence, investment proposals, policy documents, due diligence, portfolio reviews and performance reports.

Disclosure summaries: No third-party disclosure has occurred.

INTERNAL SERVICES

CGFIM is a wholly owned subsidiary of PSPIB. All internal services for CGFIM are performed by PSPIB, the whole in accordance with the IMA, and therefore all related personal information holdings are held and controlled by PSPIB. Classes of Personal Information

Classes of personal information describe personal information which is not used for administrative purposes (a decision-making process that directly affects the individual to whom the personal information pertains) nor is it intended to be retrievable by personal identifiers.

While conducting the activities of CGFIM, categories of personal information may be accumulated which are not contained in specific information banks described in this chapter.

Unsolicited Communications

Such information could include unsolicited opinions, enquiries, complaints, and general correspondence received from external organizations and individuals. The personal information contained in this class normally includes the name, and address of the individual; however, this form of personal information may exist in a fragmented form and may not always be retrievable by any personal identifier. The retention periods associated with these classes of personal information are consistent with the general subject files wherein they are stored.

Manuals

For the purposes of *Info Source*, manuals are defined as instructions, handbooks or procedures used by employees to carry out institutional programs or activities that affect the general public. Manuals that meet this definition include:

- Access to Information Manual and Procedure
- Privacy Policy and Privacy Procedure

In accordance with the *Access to Information Act* and the *Privacy Act*, an area on the premises will be made available to review original materials on site if that is the applicant's preference (and it is practical to do so), or if it is not practical to create copies of the material.

Please note: Each request made to CGFIM under the *Access to Information Act* must be accompanied by an application fee of \$5. For requests made online, this is paid at the time of application via credit card. For requests made by mail, this should be paid by enclosing cheque or money order made payable to the CGFIM.
